In April 2021, the last transnational project meeting was used to critically reflect on the didactically high-quality case studies, the manual for the development of didactically sound case studies and the Online-Planning-Guide "How to teach business cases supported by digital technologies" in the project consortium against the background of the findings from the two-stage test procedure. In this way, final adaptation needs were identified, which were subsequently taken into account by the project leaders in the optimisation and finalisation of the products.

Current project status

Currently, the case studies, the manual "How to write pedagogically designed business cases" as well as the Online-Planning-Guide for the digital, transnational use of case studies are undergoing a final quality check and all preparations are being made for the publication of the products as Open Educational Resources (OER).
