### **Review**

In December 2020, the second test phase took place at the four universities within tandems. Here, the case studies and the Online-Planning-Guide were used and tested again in the university context - with new test persons. Students from two universities worked together on the case studies as transnational small groups and presented the results in a digital live conference. A final evaluation with the participating students and lecturers rounded off the test phase and gave new insights into the assessment of the case studies and the multinational cooperation in learning tandems via digital media. The qualitative and quantitative evaluation questionnaires were then analysed and evaluated.

**Current project status** 

In April 2021, the final transnational project meeting was held, attended by the main stakeholders from Belgium, the Czech Republic, Poland and Germany.

The meeting was used to discuss and critically reflect on the findings from the second test. Final optimisation needs for the case studies, the manual "How to write pedagogically designed business cases" and the Online-Planning-Guide for the transnational, digital use of case studies could be identified and fixed in writing by the project team.

Furthermore, the meeting served to discuss the provision of all project results and the calibration of further dissemination activities to publicise the e<sup>3</sup>Cases project.

## **Prospect**

Currently, the case studies, the manual and the Online-Planning-Guide are being optimised and finalised within the project team before preparations are made for publication as OER at the end of the project.
